# Call for Papers

For this purpose, the NAFC's Committee invites academics, practitioners, observers and students in Economics, Law, Social, Psychology, Management, Administration and Accounting to do field research or library research and present the results of their studies which are related to the above theme.

Ideas and research findings from the papers will be published in Asia Pacific Fraud Journal and will be included as part of presented papers in [International Conference on Financial Criminology](#). Hopefully the papers' recommendations would be taken into consideration by policy makers, academics as well as researchers, and practitioners in the future studies.

#### **CRITERIA OF THE PAPERS**

1. The papers are the results of empirical research and will be selected by blind review (included anti plagiarism checking).
2. The papers could be descriptive, explanatory, quantitative, qualitative, and multiparadigm research.
3. Field of study of the papers are:  
Economics: Macro/Micro; Development/Regional Autonomy Studies; Monetary/Fiscal/ Banking; Poverty/ Industry/ Labor Studies; Good Corporate/Public Governance Studies (related fraud-corruption studies).

Law: Criminal Law; Constitutional Law; Civil Law (related fraud-corruption studies).

Psychology: Clinical Psychology; Criminal Psychology; Psychology of Development; Educational Psychology; Industrial and Organizational Psychology; Social Psychology (related fraud-corruption studies).

Sociology, Politics and Anthropology: Sociological Science; Political Science; Criminological Science; Social Welfare Science; Anthropology (related fraud-corruption studies).

Management: Operation; Finance/Capital Market; Human Resources Development (related fraud-corruption studies).

Administration: Public Administration, Business Administration, Fiscal Administration

Accounting: Financial Accounting; Management Accounting; Government Accounting; Auditing (related fraud-corruption studies).

4. The papers haven't been published in any printed media, book, hand out or seminar.
5. The papers should be written in good Indonesian or English. However, the abstract should be written in English.
6. The papers should be typed in Word processing, single space, Times New Roman, size 12 pt, size of paper A4.
7. Maximum Number of pages is 10 (including figures and tables).
8. The papers should be submitted by email no later than **May 31, 2018**
9. The authors' identities should be stated separately (name, address, phone, facsimile, e-mail address, field of study, and curriculum vitae).
10. The papers to be presented in the Call for Paper Seminar will be selected and the author will be notified by **June 23, 2018**
11. The author should prepare the summary and slide presentation which should be submitted by email 1 (one) day before the Seminar.
12. The best three papers will be awarded as the best papers and will be announced at the end of the Call for Paper Seminar.
13. The copyrights of the selected paper publication will be owned by Association of Certified Fraud Examiners (ACFE) Indonesia Chapter.
14. Selected articles will be published in Asia Pacific Fraud Journal Published by ACFE Indonesia Chapter and will be presented in [International Conference on Financial Criminology](#) in Jakarta.
